

## **The witness game**

### **Game instructions**

For this game, players are divided into groups of three or four. There are 23 paintings-personal accounts. The aim of the game is for players to classify the paintings in the given categories:

- Life in hiding
- Life in concentration camps
- Life in extermination camps
- Children
- Nazis
- Kapo

Rules of the game:

1. Players are divided into groups.
2. Each group chooses one of the six categories.
3. Once a category has been chosen, the number of artwork included in it appears on the screen.
4. A painting may belong in more than one categories.
5. The members of each group choose and classify paintings in the respective category.
6. If they make a wrong guess, a message appears to inform them of their mistake.
7. Each group is allowed up to three wrong guesses. Once a group has made three wrong guesses, the game starts again from the beginning.

General notes:

- a) One group is not allowed to look at the other group's screen.
- b) In order to increase the level of difficulty, we can add time limits. For example, 10-12 minutes for the completion of the classification, depending on the age of the players.
- c) The group which completes the most categories in the shortest time wins.
